### Family Partnerships

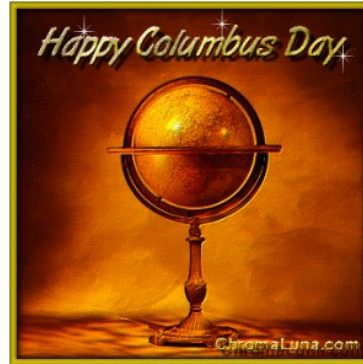
